

NATIONAL REGISTRY TO ILLINOIS LICENSE APPLICATION

If you took the National Registry Exam and want an Illinois license you must wait until you receive your NREMT card in the mail to apply for an Illinois license. ONCE RECEIVED, SUBMIT THIS FORM TO THE SYSTEM THAT EDUCATED YOU WITH THE FOLLOWING:

- Copy of your NREMT card and pass result letter
- Copy of your current CPR card
- Money order or cashier's check made payable to IDPH for \$45 for EMT-Basic or Intermediate or \$60 for Paramedic
- A completed and signed IDPH Renewal Notice form printable from www.idph.state.il.us/ems
Scroll half way down on that website and click the **Renewal Notice-PDF** form
